

Honorary Membership

- A. Persons NOT currently holding Membership, who have made a distinct contribution to the AMANJ and whose efforts deserve public recognition, shall be eligible for election as an Honorary Member.
- B. Any candidate's name for this honor shall be presented to the Board of Directors, in writing, by at least two (2) members in good standing who state the qualifications of the proposed candidate.
- C. Honorary Members shall be elected by a majority affirmative vote of the Board of Directors. The General Membership shall be notified of the proposed candidate by their respective County Presidents at least fifteen (15) days prior to the meeting of the Board of Directors.
- D. Honorary Membership shall be conferred for life. Honorary members shall be presented with a "silver" membership card and shall be exempt from the payment of annual dues.
- E. Honorary members shall be eligible to serve on committees and participate in discussions. However, Honorary members shall NOT be eligible to vote, to hold office, or to serve as Committee Chairperson, nor shall they be eligible for any Legal Benefits.
