7 Hour USPAP Course

Does the Appraisal you're preparing or reviewing meet the required standards for appraisals?

This one-day update course, copyrighted by The Appraisal Foundation, focuses on recent changes to USPAP requirements for ethical behavior and competent performance by appraisers. The course, which clarifies several commonly misunderstood aspects of USPAP, will aid appraisers in all areas of appraisal practice seeking updated competency in USPAP, including those subject to state licensing or certification and continuing education requirements. The 2010-2011 material presents day-to-day, real life situations in all areas of valuation. Classroom discussion is encouraged and required!

This course is mandatory for appraisers and special for assessors. Since many New Jersey tax assessors are also licensed New Jersey real estate appraisers and many real estate appraisers are also tax assessor certificate holders, in April, 2004, the Tax Assessor Continuing Eligibility Board (C.E.E.B.) and the New Jersey State Board of Real Estate Appraisers agreed to the use of reciprocal credits by individuals with assessor or appraisal certified licenses.

This agreement involves only appraisal courses with one exception. The exception is Uniform Standards for Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP) courses. Since the CEEB considers USPAP to be property tax administration, appraisers can opt to use USPAP courses approved for Appraiser Board credits or property tax administration credits. Application for 7 CEU's has been made.
