6. An explanation of how you expect to pay your tuition, room and board, books/supplies, etc. At the college/school of your choice.

### **Selection**

At a subsequent meeting the Foundation determines the number and amount of scholarships it can award that year. A final ranking of the applicants is determined by compiling and averaging the foundation members

Applicants are informed of the Foundation's decision in writing, by the chairperson. The successful candidates are also acknowledged at a subsequent General Membership meeting of the AMANJ.
