- 2. Request the High School Guidance Office to forward the most recent transcripts of your records, including the latest sat scores, directly to the foundation secretary.
- 3. Copies of any correspondence you have received pertaining to your application for admittance.
- 4. A list of every application for financial aid/scholarships that you have submitted, as well as any correspondence you have received pertaining to your application for aid.
- 5. A copy of any correspondence relating to the items above that you received after the filing of your Ken Beck scholarship application.
- 6. An explanation of how you expect to pay your tuition, room and board, books/supplies, etc. At the college/school of your choice.
- 7. Failure of an applicant to supply this foundation with the requested information may result in your application not being considered.
- 8. If you are selected to receive a scholarship, you <u>must notify</u> the secretary, in writing, the name of the college/school you will be attending, the address, and your school ID number by separate letter prior to a check being issued. This applies to <u>all recipients</u>.

Be a High School student in their senior year preparing to graduate and attend an institution of learning on a full time basis to continue a formal education.

Submit a completed application, including all items on the cover letter where applicable, by the established deadline of May 1st,

Selection

Applications can be obtained by writing the Foundation Secretary at City Hall, 280 Grove St - Room 116, Jersey City, NJ 07302 or by download from the Associations web site, www.AMANJ.org.

Applications received prior to the deadline are distributed to the Foundation members for review. Candidates are rated based upon the following categories:

Academic Achievements
Essay
School & Community Activities
Work Experience (Paid & Unpaid)
Neatness & Completeness of Application
Financial Need

At a subsequent meeting the Foundation determines the number and amount of scholarships it can award that year. A final ranking of the applicants is determined by compiling and averaging the foundation members

Applicants are informed of the Foundation's decision in writing, by the chairperson. The successful candidates are also acknowledged at a subsequent General Membership meeting of the AMANJ.

Payments

Payments are made, in accordance with the AMANJ Bylaws Article VIII, Section 4C by September 1st following the awarding of a scholarship.
